

Parent Engagement session overview.

E-Safety.

This session will give you information about internet safety and how to keep your child safe online. There will be opportunities to ask staff questions and to learn how to identify the risks that pupils may encounter whilst using the internet.

Autism and Challenging Behaviour.

During this session you will learn about how the school supports pupils with Autism, how you can support a child with Autism and where you can seek support and advice in the local community. Staff will advise on the strategies that we use in school, and there will be an opportunity to speak to staff.

Introduction to BSL/PECS.

Within this session there will be an opportunity to learn some BSL sign language that can be used both at home and school. There will be a demonstration of PECS and how it is used to assist and develop communication. Resources that are used to support communication will be available for demonstration.
